Aiming to cultivate researchers with a broad international outlook, this fellowship grants exceptional young Japanese researchers the opportunity to conduct long-term research at an overseas university or research institution.

[Application Period]

By April

Roundtrip international airfare (Including family members)

· Accommodation and research activity expenses

The amount of maintenance allowance's differs by destination country/region; approximately 4.5-7.5 million yen per year.

Fulbright Grants (Research Program)

(Outline)

This grant is intended to provide an opportunity to conduct research under the auspices of U.S. professors and researchers at U.S. institutions of higher education or research institutes to develop and deepen one's subject matter expertise in an academic field which is defined by the committee. Seeking a doctoral degree is not permitted.

[Application Period]

By July

[Field of Research]

Humanities, **Social Sciences**, Natural Sciences, Applied Sciences (including Engineering)
Applicants proposing interdisciplinary study or research between any of the above fields are also eligible for grants

[Scale of Funds]

Round-trip travel allowance, round-trip luggage allowance, accommodation/housing allowance, family allowance, research expenses, post-arrival miscellaneous expenses
*Accommodation/housing allowance will depend on the area of residence; \$3,164~\$4,805 per month.

[Period of Support]

3 to 9 months

The Kajima Foundation Researcher Exchange Support

[Outline]

To advance Japan's academic development and foster international scholarly exchange, this program supports researchers' overseas missions aimed at enhancing societal well-being across natural sciences (including engineering), humanities, social sciences, and interdisciplinary fields.

[Application Period]

July to October

(Field of Research)

- (1) Urban and residential environment improvement
- (2) Effective use of land and resources
- (3) Disaster prevention and risk management
- (4) Cultural and natural environment preservation

As well as fields related to social systems, information technology and other advanced technologies related to (1) through (4) above.

[Scale of Funds]

Long-term Research Program: Travel and accommodation expenses (15,000 yen/day) (Short-term and foreign researcher invitation programs are also available.)

In principle, within 1 year

Harvard-Yenching Institute Visiting Scholars Program

[Outline]

This program offers faculty members in the humanities and social sciences the opportunity to undertake 10 months of study and research at Harvard University and/or other appropriate universities.

[Application Period]

Until September

[Field of Research]

Anthropology, archaeology, area and international studies, art and architectural history, history (including economic and legal history), linguistics, literature, media and film studies, philosophy, politics, sociology, study of religion and women, gender and sexuality studies

[Scale of Funds]

Round-trip, accommodation (\$7,500/month for 10 months), health insurance (up to \$5,500), expenses for hiring research assistants, and expenses for conferences and business trips held in North America (up to \$5,000)

[Period of Support]

Up to 10 months

The Telecommunications Advancement Foundation Long-term Overseas Research Grant

[Outline]

To contribute to the dissemination, promotion, and development of information and telecommunications, the Foundation provides partial financial support for researchers in the fields of information and telecommunications (including research in the humanities, social sciences, technology, and interdisciplinary fields) to conduct excellent research activities overseas for an extended period.

[Application Period]

April to May

Scale of Funds

- (1) A portion of accommodation expenses (in principle, up to US \$80 per day)
